Eagle Scout Project Presentation - Jack Rigoni

Jack R. presented his Eagle project to the group. Jack R. plans on installing a bike repair station within Township (aka Airplane) Park in Edwardsville by the bike trail access to the park. The repair station would be a permanent fixture that is bolted to a concrete pad.

Jack R. is working with the township office to determine placement and design. Several discussion points on funding came up as well as suggestions for fundraising. Currently Jack R. expects the project to be take about \$2000 total, require 10 scouts to assist and would like to see this done before winter 2022.

Committee approved of the project unanimously, but recommended Jack R. solidify some of the details.
